6. Tuition is \$700. A minimum deposit of \$250 is due by February 27, 2026; tuition remainder is due in full by March 27, 2026. Limited financial aid is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

REFUND POLICY: Upon acceptance to the program, participants are billed in the amount of the tuition minus any scholarship offered. Total refund of tuition paid is available if the participant notifies Shakespeare & Company more than two weeks prior to the start of the program. Participant receives 50% reimbursement if notification of withdrawal from program is received within two weeks of the start of the program. No refunds are given once the program has begun.

LATE PAYMENT FEE: All late payments will be charged a \$25 fee.
